Q: How do I register my child for Life Group?

A: First-time visitors register children at the Welcome Center in the north Children's Lobby where you will receive a security label.

Q: What should I bring for preschool Life Groups?

A: Children may bring a labeled bag to include any pre-mixed bottles, baby self-feeding dry snacks, diapering supplies or a change of clothes, and any sippy or water bottles. All items must be labeled for your safety and convenience.

Q: What if my child has allergies or other special needs?

A: Upon registration, you will note allergies on your information sheet so an allergy will be indicated on your child's name tag. Their Life Group teacher will be ready to hear any special instructions or accommodations your child may need for a safe and rich Life Group time. If additional accommodations are required, our Preschool Ministry staff is available to help ensure a smooth experience for your child.

Q: If my child needs me, will I be contacted in adult Life Groups/Worship services?

A: Yes! If your child needs you, our staff will contact you at the cell phone number you provide.

Q: What can my child expect in their Life Group?

A: Preschoolers in our Infants, Babies, and Toddlers Life Groups will receive warm care and an atmosphere of prayer, songs, readings from the Beginner's Bible® and interaction with our background-screened team of volunteer teachers. Preschoolers in our 2's-Prek Life Groups will experience Bible lessons from The Big Picture Interactive Bible Storybook®, as well as preschool worship time, snack, and freeplay or playground time weather permitting.
